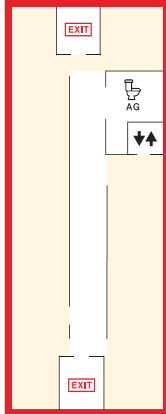

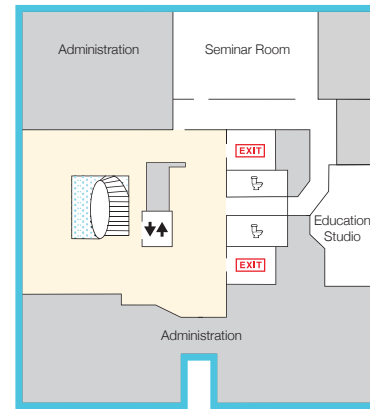
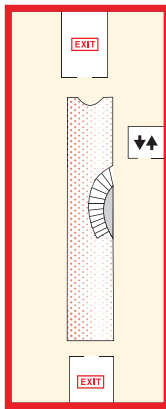

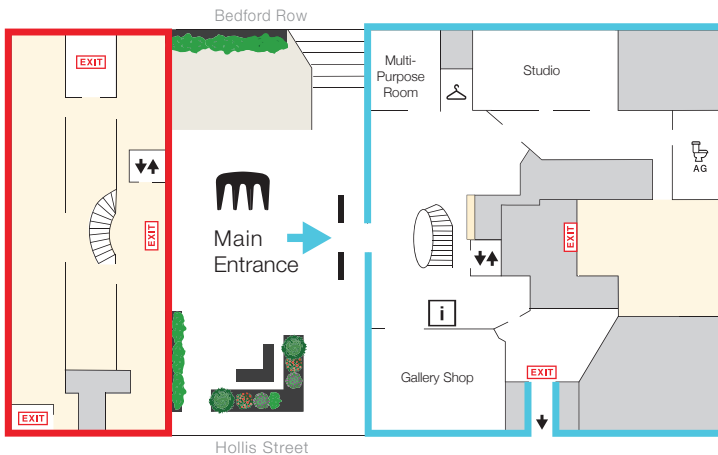

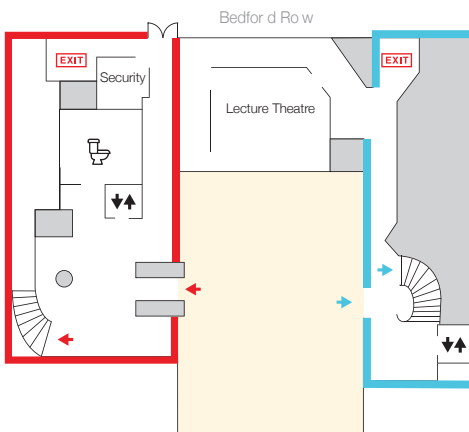

The Art Gallery occupies two buildings, South and North, that are connected by the Lower Level under the Courtyard. Level 3, North is only accessible via the elevator. The exterior elevator signage matches the map and will show you which level you are on.
